TARIFFS' EFFECT ON CAR WASH

We have received notices from multiple raw material vendors about immediate price increases due to the newly imposed tariffs. They are having the effect of reducing imported steel and increasing the utilization of domestic mills, both of which are feeding substantial cost increases. Stainless steel tubing and fittings will be going up 15-20% effective at the end of this month. OEM's will be feeling this pressure as well. Although they do have some forward contracts on steel, we expect pricing on equipment all manufacturers increase due to the tariffs later this spring. If you are considering any equipment upgrades with high metal content, you may want to lock in your price now to capture the savings.
