

BLOWER IMPELLER INSPECTIONS

All automatic and tunnel car wash owners should inspect their blower impellers annually. The concern is stress fractures from operation that could cause the impeller to come apart. If you have any question on how to do the inspection please call our Parts/Service Counter or feel free to email pictures of any areas of concern.

The damage that could possibly occur and liability associated are reasons enough to do the annual inspection. Below is a photo of a cracked weld on an impeller found during an inspection.

NEW WASH IN LOVELAND
